

## **AFE Proposal Development Guideline**

## Country Specific Call: Egypt

This document details important information that will inform your application process, this document is intended for the Egypt-specific call for proposals 2021

- 1- Each group/CSO can apply with up to 2 project proposals
- 2- Shortlisted applicants will be notified and further engaged by the 8th of December 2020
- 3- Eligibility criteria:
  - a. Budget must adhere to grant guidelines (10,000 USD)
  - Proposed project must be relevant to the theme of the call (Activities that focus on security, safety and emergency, Projects/ activities that support creating safe spaces and support groups online and offline, Projects/ activities that build communities and campaigning.)
  - c. Project must be implemented in relevant geographical area (Egypt)
  - d. Project timeline must adhere to grant guidelines (12 months)
  - e. Applicant must not be an AFE staff member or relative
  - f. Applicant must not have received two consecutive competitive grants from AFE
  - g. Applicant must not have an ongoing grant with AFE
  - h. Cost estimation in budget breakdown must be realistic
  - i. Indirect costs must not exceed 20% of total grant budget (2,000 USD)
  - Budget items must be clear with notes explaining unclear items where necessary
  - k. Budget must be prepared in USD
  - Project proposals must be submitted before Monday November 30<sup>th</sup> 6:00 PM (GMT+2)
  - m. Shortlisted applicants must further engage in the participatory selection procedures.

AFE will be open to receiving clarifying questions through <u>grants@afemena.org</u> starting Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> of November - 10:00 AM (GMT+2) until Wednesday the 11<sup>th</sup> of November - 6:00 PM (GMT+2) - Answers will be published by the 18<sup>th</sup> of November, on the AFE website.
